## HOW TO MAKE AN ORIGAMI ROCKET. MASTER CLASS





The following materials and tools will be required.

#### **MATERIALS AND TOOLS**

- A square sheet of paper (it can be special paper for origami or ordinary office paper, preferably coloured. Coloured office paper is also good in that it is double-sided)
- Scissors
- Glue
- For the first design option: felt-tip pens or coloured pencils and a small piece of white paper
- For the second design option: coloured paper

### **STAGES OF WORK**


Cut a square of the maximum possible size out of an A4 sheet of office paper – this will be sufficient for one origami rocket. Alternatively, divide the sheet in half and cut out two squares: you will get two origami rockets about 15cm long which are convenient to use as bookmarks. Let the master class begin!


# THE BASIS OF THE ROCKET IS THE CRAFTSMANSHIP




STEP

Fold your square sheet of paper in half vertically. Then fold the paper so that the left edge meets the centre crease that you have just made and do the same with the other side so that the right edge also meets the centre crease.






2 Z Open up your paper and fold the top left corner down so that it again meets the centre crease and do the same with the other side so that the top right corner also meets the centre crease. Then fold the right edge over so that it meets the left furthest crease on your piece of paper.




**3** 

Fold this part of the paper back over itself so that the crease follows the original centre crease of the rocket.



STEP 21

Repeat step 3 for the other side.




5 5 The resulting figure should look like this image.





Cut two triangle shapes from each side of the bottom of the rocket as in the image.



Flip the paper over for your result!










#### **DESIGN**


OPTION

Draw circles on your rocket with colored pencils. Next draw, cut out, and glue flames to the bottom of your rocket.



NOIL AO

Draw and cut out both flames and circles out of colored paper and glue them to your rocket.
